A Message from the President and CEO

Thank you. These two words barely scratch the surface of my deep gratitude for each member of our Melmark community. No one could have anticipated what occurred in this year, a global pandemic, a racial reckoning around social justice in our country and trying to still meet the complex needs of those we serve every day. Over the past year, we have faced unfathomable obstacles, costing Melmark almost \$3.5 million dollars of unplanned expenses. All of these issues have placed immense pressure on our highly skilled staff to put our mission before everything else, and forced families to painfully remain apart from their loved ones for extended periods of time, while trusting Melmark to care for their family members in the middle of a global pandemic.

During such uncertainty for all of us, we did not know what to expect from our philanthropic partners, who already give so much to support Melmark's programs and, quite frankly, were facing their own challenges due to the COVID-19 pandemic. What we witnessed was awe-inspiring. The entire Melmark community, from our long-time corporate partners, donor families, and volunteers to our caregivers, neighbors, and quite a few new friends, came together in a way we have never witnessed in Melmark's history. Their collective commitment to supporting our mission-first staff and the individuals we serve has been one of the most humbling (yet challenging) experiences of my lifetime.

What I have witnessed from our teams across Melmark's service divisions in Pennsylvania, New England and the Carolinas has been equally moving. Our staff, at every level of the organization, continued their mission-driven work even as many experienced personal losses of parents, grandparents and other loved ones due to COVID-19. Our community has simply remained committed during the hardest of times.

Melmark's leadership team has navigated more than 500 pieces of guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), state, and local regulatory bodies, making fast, evidence-based decisions with knowledge, conviction and grace. Information surrounding the virus continues to be constantly monitored, acted upon and communicated to employees, families, and stakeholders. Vaccines, COVID-19 tests, personal protective equipment, sanitizers, signage, and physical barriers have been sourced and implemented throughout the pandemic. This has taken endless hours of work on the part of behind-the-scenes staff and front-line personnel.

Figuring out how to finance the significant cost of the COVID-19 pandemic has been an entirely separate endeavor, but because of our strategic plan of 2017, and thanks to the generosity of our donor community, Melmark is more strongly positioned than many other not-for-profit organizations in our region and across the country. This stability, due to fiscal prudence before the COVID-19 pandemic, combined with the past year's historic endowment gift of \$21.5 million from the Anne and Brutus Kenan Fund, provides additional security for Melmark's future. We simply would not be where we are today without our donor community.

I hope, when you take a moment to look back on the past year, you feel a sense of pride in knowing all the ways you supported the individuals at Melmark, their families, and one another during the most difficult time in our history. I know I am certainly reminded that, together as a community, we have and will continue to accomplish so much. I'm sure I will tell my grandchildren about the time a singular generation of committed employees kept Melmark on track, despite their own fears of COVID-19, while still ensuring we remained **Mission First. Every Individual. Every Day.**

Melmark is a multi-state human service provider with premier private special education schools, professional development, training, and research centers.

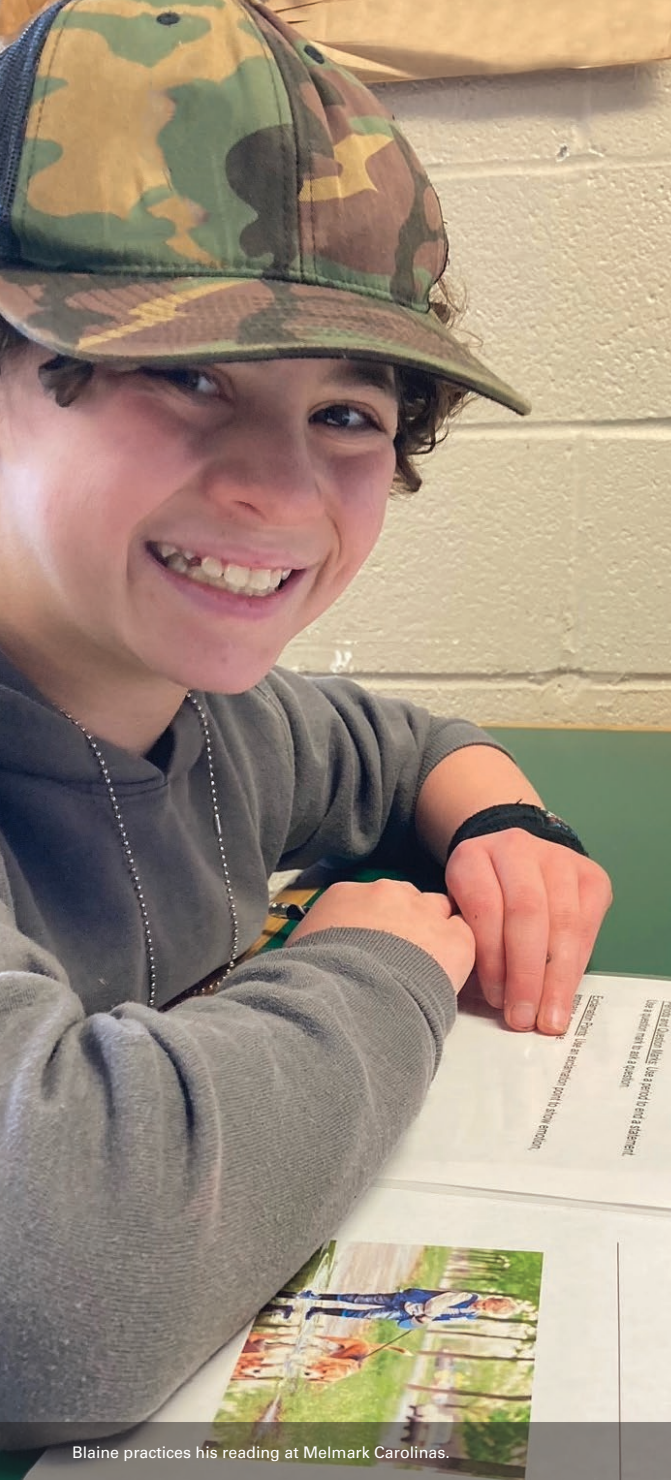



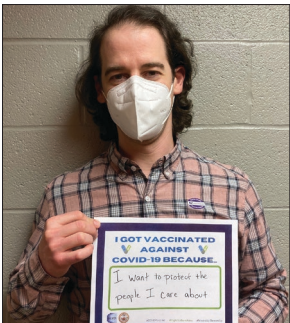

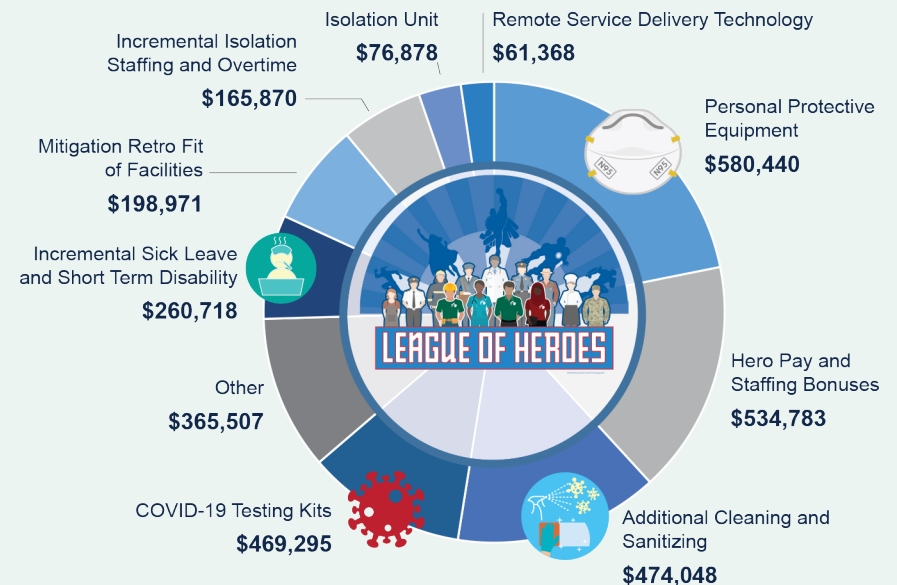

Her foundation provides grant support to a variety of autism-related organizations nationwide and, in 2021, she was named Chair, Board of Directors of the Autism Society of America.

Gregg and Lori's adult son, Vinnie, was the impetus for them to create Extraordinary Ventures (EV) in 2007, a non-profit organization formed in collaboration with a number of other families in Chapel Hill. Their goal was to create sustainable businesses operated by a neuro-diverse workforce. Their mission for these endeavors is extraordinary – to enable every individual in our society the opportunity to achieve their highest quality of life, regardless of their intellectual and developmental disabilities. From candle sales, dog walking and laundry services to performing office tasks, the EV businesses provide real solutions for everyday needs of the community, while simultaneously creating paid job opportunities for the individuals they employ.

Last December, Lori attended our virtual Coffee with the CEO presentation for key donors and friends. Rita M. Gardner, M.P.H., LABA, BCBA, Melmark President and CEO, shared insights and updates pertaining to the pandemic and strategic organizational initiatives at all three Melmark divisions.

From her work in the Carolinas, Lori knows all too well that children and adults in her region with complex diagnoses of autism, intellectual and developmental disabilities are often subject to homebound education equivalent to only a few hours a week, and that they receive minimal, if any, evidence-based services. She shares Melmark's desire to advance the educational offerings available for these children, and to expand the Melmark model of service delivery across North and South Carolina, and beyond. Lori is a staunch advocate for improved systems of care, and for creating sustaining legislation and policies to benefit these most vulnerable children and adults. As her daughter, Lucy, a special needs attorney told her,

"We need to have a long term relationship with Melmark Carolinas. They are making such a difference in the lives of these children."

Her passion and enthusiasm for Doctors Brad Stevenson and Keri Bethune and all the Melmark Carolinas' day school staff led to The Ireland Family Foundation making a very generous year-end gift to the organization's fundraising appeal. The Ferraro Family Simplicity and Significance of Recurring Gifts

Recurring gifts represent a donor's commitment to providing regular, ongoing support for an organization, without the binding or long-term commitment of a pledge. These gifts, over the course of a year, are often larger, and make a greater impact, than what the donor would be capable of giving as one donation.

Typically, recurring gifts apply to donors who make a monthly recurring donation, but it can also include quarterly donations or even annual support. Often, recurring giving involves automatic payments via a credit card or bank transfer/e-check, which makes it convenient for the donor(s).

Here at Melmark New England, recurring gifts are welcome and encouraged as they provide a steady stream of reliable revenue for designated programs or services. Several parents have seen that even a smaller, monthly donation can amount to a very generous annual gift.

Karen "KC" Crane was an active member in many Melmark programs and was very athletic in her youth. She participated in the Meadows Program, The Melmark Players, The Joybells and various Special Olympics programs over the years. She always had a soft, beautiful smile and greeting for others. Her humor and positive outlook on life was truly endearing to all who were fortunate enough to have known her.

After 43 fun-filled years at Melmark, Karen Crane passed away at the age of 55. When her health declined three years ago, she was placed on hospice. Karen's last years were both a miracle and a testament to the quality care that she received from her loving and dedicated staff. Medical professionals exclaimed in wonder multiple times over the years when, for 18 times, she was placed on and taken off hospice. That again, is due to the excellent care she received from her staff.

In addition to having benefited from the love, support, and excellent medical and rehabilitative support at Melmark, Karen also was so fortunate to have had a close and loving family. Dr. Howard and Mara Mayer Giving through Donor-Advised Funds

A donor-advised fund (DAF) is a charitable giving vehicle administered by a public charity. Fidelity Charitable Gift Fund is the largest DAF in the United States, with \$34.5B in assets as of June 30, 2020. Donor-advised funds are the fastest-growing charitable giving vehicle in the United States because they are one of the easiest and most tax-advantageous ways to give to charity. When you contribute cash, securities or other assets to a donor-advised fund, you are generally eligible to take an immediate tax deduction, and the funds are invested for tax-free growth. The donor also plays a role in designating distributions from the DAF, to charities of their choice, including Melmark.

More and more donors to Melmark's three divisions are utilizing these charitable investment accounts, including Dr. Howard and Mara Mayer, parents of two Melmark New England residential students. Designations from a donor-advised fund may be accepted in any amount and can be directed to current programs and services or to the endowment fund. The convenience of having one fund from which to make annual, routine, or multiple designations makes it attractive to the Mayers, and to other Melmark donors.

An individual donor may also elect to create a lasting legacy by naming Melmark (or a specific division), to be a beneficiary, in full or as a percentage of the Fund. Happily, 45 years later, Melmark has been Lori’s home, her safe haven and her family.

We chose to make a meaningful gift to Melmark because we are profoundly grateful for the expert, skilled, kind, compassionate and healing care she has received and for bringing her to her potential and even beyond... she has been cared for carefully and with love. What more could we ask for?

At the same time that we decided to give a substantial gift to Melmark to show our appreciation, there were new regulations that permitted up to \$100,000 a year could be taken out of an IRA as an offset to the federal income tax. It seemed like a perfect way to make a generous gift.”

Fred and Vicki are using a qualified distribution from their IRA to make gifts to Melmark. This creative way of giving benefits donors by lowering their adjusted gross income.

The Marcus Family Supporting Melmark and Each Other

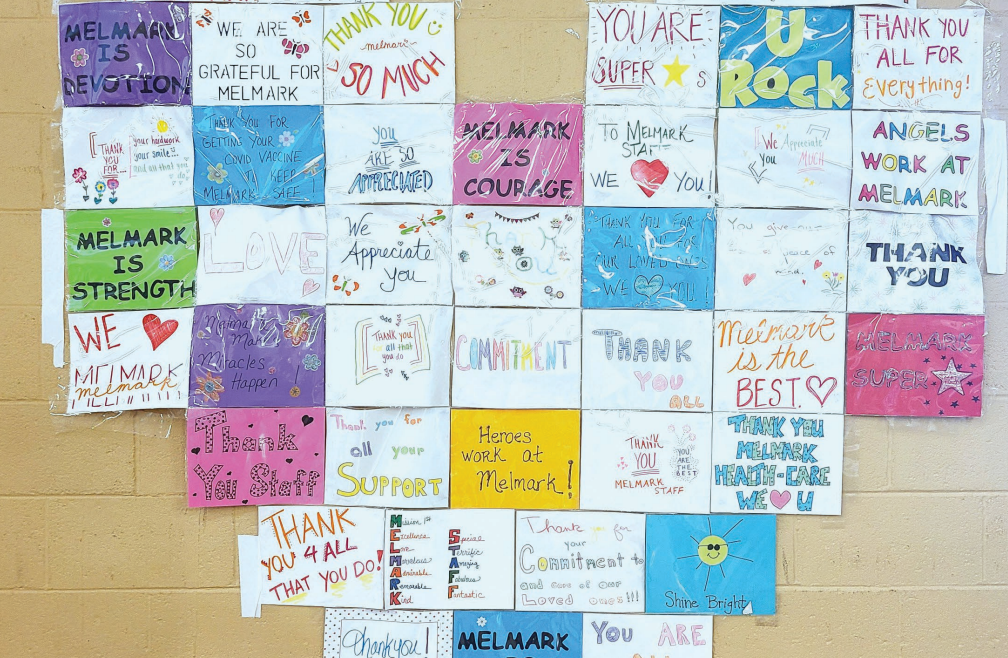

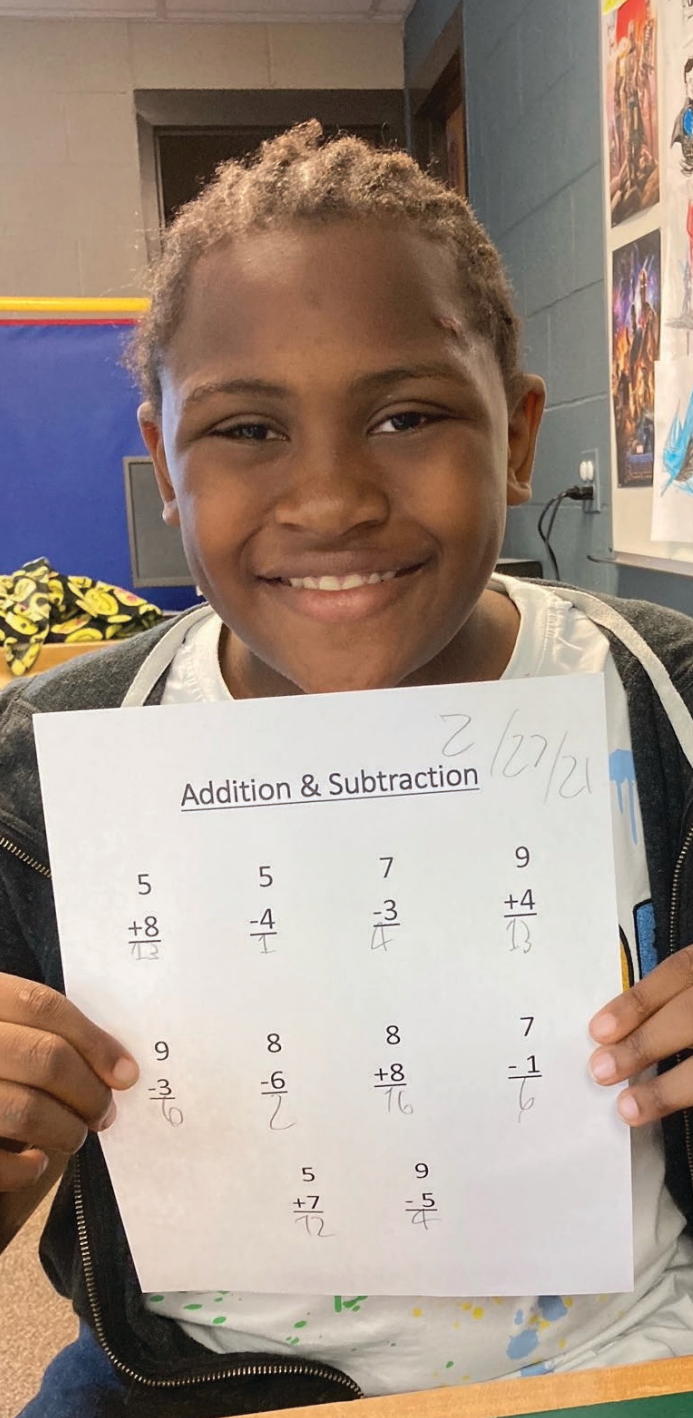

Annual Giving

Gifts of Stock

The Paul and Mildred Krentel Legacy Society, founded in 2010, includes individuals who have named Melmark as a beneficiary of their estate plan. Such gifts can include a bequest or beneficiary designation in a retirement plan and/or charitable income gifts, such as:

- Charitable Gift Annuities
- Charitable Remainder Unitrusts
- Gifts of Life Insurance

In-Kind Gifts

A Gift-In-Kind is a contribution of goods or services that can be used to advance Melmark's mission, or can be readily converted to cash and may qualify as a charitable deduction.

Pennsylvania United Way

A number of Melmark's donors prefer to make their contributions through the United Way payroll deduction program. Melmark is a participating donor choice agency in the United Way of Southeastern Pennsylvania; the code number is 1012.

Pennsylvania Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC)

The Pennsylvania Educational Improvement Tax Credit (PA EITC) program allows businesses in the Commonwealth to earn a tax credit of up to 90% for certain Pennsylvania taxes when they make a donation to a "scholarship organization" or an "educational improvement organization," a special category under the state tax code. Melmark has been approved as an Educational Improvement Organization (EIO). Funds received under these programs provide funding for technology to enhance our students' experiences.

Corporate, Foundation and Organization Giving

Melmark has been very fortunate to have the support of local corporations, foundations and organizations. These benefactors have extended their valued time and financial resources in support of our mission. Many prominent organizations regularly include Melmark in their contributions budget.

New England Legacy Brick Walkway
